Information about the Redress Scheme for survivors of institutional child sexual abuse

In November 2016 the Australian Government advised it would be establishing a Redress Scheme for survivors of institutional childhood sexual abuse.

The following information has been made available about the scheme:

- Once the law setting up the scheme has gone through, the scheme will start in 2018.
- Survivors who experienced childhood sexual abuse in Commonwealth, NSW, Victorian or ACT government institutions will be able to access redress under the scheme.
- 3. The scheme will offer the following:
 - i. A monetary payment up to \$150,000; and
 - ii. psychological counselling support; and
 - iii. if requested, a direct personal acknowledgment and response from the responsible institution.

- Survivors who have received redress under other schemes can still apply to this scheme, however prior relevant payments may be taken into account.
- 5. No-one can apply until the scheme starts.
- A dedicated telephone helpline and website will be available to provide information to survivors about the scheme.
- 7. The Australian Government is strongly encouraging the other states and territories and all relevant institutions to opt in to the scheme.
